ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 5 OF THE YUBA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE - FILE #ZC 04-03 & #ZC 04-04

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Chapter 5 of Title 8 of the Yuba City Municipal Code is amended as set forth in the following particulars:

a. Section 8-5.1502. of the Yuba City Municipal Code entitled "Uses" is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

d. Sec. 8-5.1502. of the Yuba City Municipal Code entitled "Uses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

e. Article 52 is hereby added to Title 8, Chapter 5 of the Yuba City Municipal Code to read as follows:

Sec. 8-5.5201. Prohibited Uses.

A. The following is prohibited in all zoning districts:

1. Medical Marijuana Dispensary.

Section 2: Save and except as herein amended, each and every provision of Title 8, Chapter 5, of the Yuba City Municipal Code, is hereby republished, readopted and reaffirmed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its adoption and after it is adopted, it shall be published as provided for by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 003-05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY
AMENDING SECTION 8-5.5201(A)1 OF THE YUBA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE
REGARDING MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUBA CITY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 8-5.5201(A)1 of the Yuba City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A)1. Medical Marijuana Dispensary. "Medical Marijuana Dispensary" means any facility or location where medical marijuana is made available to and/or distributed by or to three or more of the following: a primary caregiver, a qualified patient, or a person with an identification card, in strict accordance with California Health and Safety Code Section 11362.5 et seq. A "medical marijuana dispensary" shall not include the following uses, as long as the location of such uses are otherwise regulated by this Code or applicable law: a clinic licensed pursuant to Chapter 1 of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, a health care facility licensed pursuant to Chapter 2 of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, a residential care facility for persons with chronic life-threatening illness licensed pursuant to Chapter 3.01 of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, a residential care facility for the elderly licensed pursuant to Chapter 3.2 of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, a residential hospice, or a home health agency licensed pursuant to Chapter 8 of Division 2 of the Health and Safety Code, as long as any such use complies strictly with applicable law including, but not limited to, Health and Safety Code Section 11362.5 et seq.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective 30 days from and after its adoption, and after adoption shall be published as provided by law.

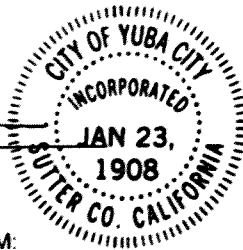
