



1 result in land uses and land developments that conflict with amendments to the  
2 Development Code that may be adopted as a result of the study that is to be undertaken.

3 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in existing law,  
4 including but not limited to the County Code and the County General Plan, no application for  
5 any permit or entitlement shall be accepted, and no permit or entitlement shall be issued,  
6 that would authorize any use or development of property for medical marijuana dispensaries  
7 within in the unincorporated area of the County.

8 SECTION 3. This ordinance is an interim ordinance adopted as an urgency  
9 measure pursuant to Government Code Section 65858, and shall serve as an extension of  
10 Urgency Interim Ordinance 4083. This ordinance shall be of no further force and effect ten  
11 months and fifteen (15) days from its date of adoption, unless it is extended by further action  
12 of the Board of Supervisors, adopted pursuant to that statute, or on the effective date of a  
13 permanent ordinance amending the Development Code, whichever occurs first.

14 SECTION 4. The Board of Supervisors declares that it would have adopted  
15 this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of it  
16 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses, phrases or  
17 portions of it be declared invalid or unconstitutional. If for any reason any portion of this  
18 ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, then all other provisions of it shall remain  
19 valid and enforceable.

20 SECTION 5. This ordinance shall in no way limit the right to possess, use or  
21 cultivate marijuana for medicinal purposes as is presently authorized or prohibited by the  
22 laws of the State of California as set forth in the Health and Safety Code, Penal Code, or  
23 other State law, or by any federal law.

24 SECTION 6. This ordinance is declared an urgency measure necessary for  
25 the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare for  
26 the reasons stated in Section 1, and it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption,  
27 pursuant to Government Code section 65858 and clause (d) of Government Code section  
28 25123.
